Background and Challenges

Ruskin High School, part of the Hickman Mills School District in Kansas City, MO, recognized the need for upgraded security measures, to continue keeping staff and students safe.

The traditional metal detectors required significant time for student screenings, often leading to delays at the start of the school day.

To address these challenges, Ruskin High School partnered with SWC to implement a comprehensive plan, including:


